Traffic Safety Tips

Dear Parents,

Each year the start of school brings increased attention to traffic safety concerns in and around our neighborhood schools. The Wyoming Police Department and the Wyoming School District are working together to provide a safe environment for our students who travel to and from school every day. These efforts include the Police Department actively enforcing laws relating to speed limits in school zones, school bus safety and student pick up and drop off areas. A large part of our success in maintaining a safe environment involves the participation of parents. As a reminder, here are just a few tips to keep in mind when either transporting or sending your students to school.

- Always be aware of your speed. The speed limit in school zones is 20 mph.
- When dropping off your children, do not stop in the roadway. Pull safely into a designated parking/drop-off area.
- Do not park close to the crosswalk. This obstructs the view of the crosswalk to other vehicles, school crossing guards and children.
- Do not park in areas that say "No Parking During School Hours".
- Have your children cross the street at crosswalks.
- Do not make U-turns or turn around in a school zone.
- Do not use driveways to turn around, please approach the school zone from the correct direction.

By working together and following these tips, we can help keep the streets safe for our children this school year. Thank you.
