



About PSA

PSA is the **Wyoming Parent School Association**, a non-profit organization established in 1915 and dedicated to fostering a closer relationship between parents and the Wyoming City Schools. Unique to Wyoming, there is only one parent organization working to serve the entire school district. PSA's mission is to support Wyoming City schools through volunteerism and fundraising.

During the 2010-2011 school year, PSA provided the Wyoming Schools with hundreds of hours of invaluable volunteer help at the Primary, Middle School and High School levels. **Over \$100,000 was raised to support the schools and fund a wide variety of programs and enrichment opportunities.**

PSA Income/Receipts

Although PSA has many fundraising events and activities, oftentimes the success of a select few, contribute to the overall income for the organization. PSA's ability to fund the needs of the school system depends totally on the success of the fundraising events and activities. The income from the prior school year activities/events, are used to fund PSA and school needs for the following school year. This is displayed on the Financial Summary mentioned above.

The 2010-2011 school year activities/events brought in approximately \$102,000, after deductions for the 6th and 8th grade class trips. The PSA largest events were Magazine Sales – over \$35,000; May Fete – \$27,000; Primary Fundraiser – over \$13,000; Non-Event - \$12,000; and Boxtops/School Supplies - \$8,000. This money, and any prior year surplus, is used to fulfill the requests for the 2011-2012 school year.

PSA Expenditures

Through fundraising activities, PSA is able to provide much needed funding to support a multitude of needs and initiatives of all Wyoming City Schools. PSA funding has a significant impact in many very important areas that allow the Wyoming children opportunities for a high level of education and enhanced learning.

Areas that benefit from PSA activities and fundraising include such programs as Enrichment Programs, Scholastic Competitions and Clubs, and Technology Improvements for all schools; Teacher Appreciation Dinner; High School and 8th Grade Graduations. In addition, PSA funds are also used to support enhanced learning in areas of Math, Science, Physical Education, Art, and Music.
