<b>Rumpke Recycling</b>	<b>Accepted</b>	<b>NOT Accepted</b>
<p>Each school has a collection bin for recycling plastic, glass and cans.</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• <b>ALL plastic BOTTLES and JUGS</b> with lids removed – no other plastic containers.</li> <li>• Glass bottles and jars of any color</li> <li>• Aluminum, steel and bi-metal cans</li> <li>• Aerosol cans with lids and tips removed</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Plastics that are not bottles such as butter tubs, yogurt cups or food trays.</li> <li>• Light bulbs</li> <li>• Styrofoam</li> <li>• Plastic bags</li> </ul>

**All Drink Pouches (not boxes)** can be recycled in the white collection buckets located in each primary school cafeteria. It helps if any left over juice is squeezed out and the straws are removed, but the pouches do not have to be rinsed or cleaned.

**Aluminum Can Tabs** are collected at each school for the Ronald McDonald House.

As of December 2011, **we are no longer recycling bottle caps**. Aveda has discontinued free shipments of bottle caps. Hopefully, we will be able to recycle caps in our own community in the near future. We will keep you posted if anything changes.
